Ramakrishnam Raju; world renowned philosopher Shri Jiddu Krishnamurthy; world renowned educationist Dr. Cattamanchi Ramalinga Reddy; author of Maa Telugu Talliki Mallepudanda Shri Sankarambadi Sundarachari; two Speakers of Andhra Pradesh Legislative Assembly Dr. Agarala Easwara Reddi and Shri Nallari Kiran Kumar Reddy; and two Chief Ministers of Andhra Pradesh Shri Nallari Kiran Kumar Reddy and Shri Nara Chandrababu Naidu. Shri Rabindranath Tagore translated Jana Gana Mana from Bengali to English and also set it to music in Madanapalle, a town in Chittoor district.
