#### **ABOUT THE ACADEMY**

#### PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

- 1. The applicant is required to fill up the prescribed form, which can be had from the AGRASRI headquarters on payment of Rs.100/- (non-refundable) in Cash or through Bank Draft in favour of AGRASRI, Tirupati. The Academy offers Life/Ordinary, Corporate, Donor and Patron Membership, for which a membership form is prescribed. After every 10 years, the Life Membership must be renewable by the Members by paying the prescribed fee to the Academy.
- 2. The application received will be considered by the Executive Council for admission of new members. The recommendation of the Executive Council will be communicated to the applicants which generally takes 2-3 weeks.
